



Q.1: How often do teachers encourage you to learn about people from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?





Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?





Q.4: At your school, how often are you encouraged to think more deeply about race-related topics?














Q.1: How often do you spend time at school with students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?







Q.3: At your school, how often do students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures hang out with each other?





Q.4: At your school, how common is it for students to have close friends from different racial, ethnic, or cultural backgrounds?








Q.2: How often do you get so focused on activities in your classes that you lose track of time?




Q.3: In your classes, how eager are you to participate?


Q.2: How pleasant or unpleasant is the physical space at your school?






Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your school will bully you online?



Q.5: Overall, how much do you feel like you belong at your school?











Q.1: How many of your teachers are respectful towards you?



Q.2: If you walked into class upset, how many of your teachers would be concerned?




Q.3: If you came back to visit class three years from now, how many of your teachers would be excited to see you?


Q.4: When your teachers ask how you are doing, how many of them are really interested in your answer?








Q.3: Some people describe themselves as transgender when their sex assigned at birth does not match the way they think or feel about their gender. Are you transgender?





Q.4: Below is a list of terms people often use to describe their sexual orientation. How do you describe your sexual orientation?


