Given the increased media over TJ and the focus in the media that seems to be on the lottery portion of the proposed plan and not on the merit portion, I think we need some strategic communications and stronger talking points around TJ admissions, where we are in the process of any potential changes and more information on the proposed plan. I suggest we frame it on increasing diversity through redefining merit rather than through just a lottery. And that we are still working on the plan based on community and school board feedback.
