STATE OF HAWAII

COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

1. TOTAL COMPENSATION

In full consideration of goods delivered and/or services performed by the CONTRACTOR under the terms and conditions of this contract, the STATE agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR an additional amount not to exceed:

SIXTY-THOUSAND SEVEN-HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$60,750.00)

The contract price shall include all services, materials, overhead, profit, all applicable taxes, any reimbursement costs, and any other incidental and operational expenses incurred by CONTRACTOR in the performance of its obligations hereunder. The contract price shall be the all-inclusive cost to the STATE and no other charges will be honored.

The contract price to the STATE, including profit or fee, shall be adjusted to exclude any significant sums by which the STATE finds that the price was increased because the CONTRACTOR, furnished cost or pricing data that was inaccurate, incomplete, or not current as of the date agreed upon between the parties.

2. COMPENSATION RATES

- 2.1. Total Compensation shall be based on the following:
 - 2.1.1. Annual License: \$52,500.00
 - 2.1.2. Project Management: \$5,250.00
 - 2.1.3. Professional Development: \$3,000.00 for 2 virtual workshops (no additional charge for larger groups)

3. PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- 3.1. Payment for Annual License shall be made on or about November 2022 and receipt of an original invoice.
- 3.2. Payment(s) for Project Management and Professional Development shall be made upon i) satisfactory completion of services as described on Attachment-S1, Scope of Services ii) and receipt of an original invoice in accordance with the rates described in section 2, Compensation Rates above.
- 3.3. Section 103-10, HRS, provides that the STATE shall have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of invoice or satisfactory performance of services, to make payment. The STATE will not recognize any requirement established by the CONTRACTOR and communicated to the STATE which requires payment within a shorter period or interest payment not in conformance with statute.
- 3.4. Progress payment shall not be construed as an absolute acceptance of the work done up to the time of the payments, but the entire work is subject to acceptance at the time CONTRACTOR advises STATE that the work is complete.

The **final payment** on the Contract shall be for services rendered during the billing period just prior to the Contract anniversary date. A tax clearance certificate, not over two (2) months old and with an original

green "certified copy" stamp, must accompany the invoice for final payment. In addition to the tax clearance certificate, the "Certification of Compliance for Final Payment" (DOE Form-22) with an original signature will be required for final payment. CONTRACTOR may also submit an original CERTIFICATE OF VENDOR COMPLIANCE as issued by the State Procurement Office via an online system, also referred to as "Hawaii Compliance Express". TIME OF PERFORMANCE

The original Contract was for the period, November 26, 2021 through June 30, 2022 and included options to extend for <u>one</u> (1) additional twelve (12) month period at the same terms and conditions of the original contract or as negotiated between the STATE and the CONTRACTOR and contingent upon funding availability.

In accordance with the terms of the original contract, this contract is now extended for the <u>first</u> and <u>final</u> twelve (12) month period, July 01, 2022 through June 30, 2023 via Supplemental Contract No. 1.

Beyond June 30, 2023, there shall be no additional options to extend this contract.
