GOVERNANCE TIP
Written and Agreed Board Operating Protocols

The foundation for good governance includes a commitment to clear governance priorities, agreed and written protocols, and transparent predictable board processes. A board cannot do its best work without agreed and clearly written norms and protocols for how it does its work. Developing a powerful set of board operating protocols requires a conversation about values, acceptable norms of conduct, and how to work productively begeter. It is a mistake to assume or neglect to do this important work. Stephen M. R. Covey conducted research and reported on the importance of furst in relationships and organizations. His book, The Speed of Tirst. Highlights that thing get a commission ducker, with less of mana, and with less cost in reparations that have high furst. His near book, Smart Tirst, outlines the importance of accountability. Clearly written and agreed Board Operating Protocols can reduce drama from surprises and help a board hold itself and the superintendent accountable for accomplishing the mission of a school district-educating each and every child to a high level.
