8. What did you learn that you didn't know before? *

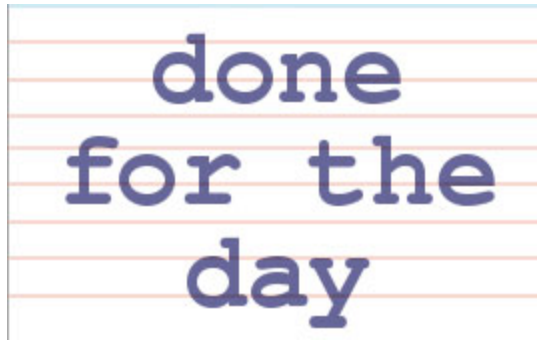
9. What did you learn that surprised you? *
