Panorama's unique product includes research-backed proprietary school climate and feedback surveys for students, families, teachers, and staff with a focus on student success, staff development, family engagement, and equity, research-backed proprietary SEL measures for students and teachers, secure online and paper survey administration functionality, interactive online and paper reports, and the Playbook intervention resource library for educators. Panorama's services include implementation support, customer service, and professional development for teachers, school leaders, and district leaders.

Panorama currently supports ten million students annually across more than 1,500 school districts nationwide, and we proudly serve as a thought partner and de facto provider for survey programs with a focus on social-emotional learning, school climate, well-being, family engagement, and equity. While other vendors offer services around student, family, or staff surveys, Panorama's solution includes unique components that will be essential to the Arlington Public Schools program, and which are not offered by other vendors. These components include proprietary survey measures, unique survey administration options, and essential reporting functionality that is not available from other providers. In particular, Panorama's proprietary social-emotional learning product is the only tool for gauging student's social-emotional development that is research-backed, includes valid and reliable measures from students and teachers, has been used at scale, and is available across grades K-12. No other platform provides the same comprehensive reporting capabilities across district-, school-, and student-level school climate and social-emotional learning data. Tools such as role-based permissioning, national benchmarks, and results disaggregated based on demographic groups are unique to Panorama's product.

Central to Arlington Public Schools' vision for this program is the opportunity to student social-emotional learning perceptions and feedback from multiple stakeholders into one program. Panorama is the only provider able to offer one integrated school improvement solution across school climate and social-emotional learning.





Understanding of Goals & Challenges

Arlington Public School's Overarching Goals (File: BA-E) outline the following long-term strategic vision and goals which align to the Panorama partnership in the following ways:

Goal One - Student Achievement

The Arlington Public Schools will ensure that every graduate is prepared to enter and complete a post-secondary degree program, pursue a career, and be an active citizen in an ever-changing world by offering a rigorous, comprehensive, standards-based and data-driven K-12 system of curriculum, instruction, and assessment that integrates social, emotional and wellness support.

How Panorama helps

Panorama provides research-backed survey instruments for students, families, teachers, and staff to integrate social, emotional, and wellness in the service of student achievement. Social-emotional learning is an important part of a well-rounded education, and a domain in which Arlington Public Schools have invested considerably. Panorama provides a means to elevate and measure student voice, which directly supports Arlington's focus on SEL and allows the district to 1) validate the efficacy of current investments; 2) identify focus areas; 3) deepen its focus on 3 key CASEL skills: Relationships, Self-Awareness, and Self-Management.

A <u>2017 meta-analysis from CASEL</u> shows that investment in SEL has led to improved classroom behavior and 13 percent gains in academics. Panorama provides one platform to measure, understand, and act on SEL data. If Arlington Public Schools have access to clear data and trends for every student and in aggregate, then they will be able to make informed decisions and prioritize support for individuals and groups of students.

Client spotlight

Framingham Public Schools began working with Panorama to measure students' perceptions of school climate and student engagement, which they knew to correlate positively with students' behavioral, emotional, and academic outcomes. Superintendent Dr. Robert Tremblay led one of our webinars: *Using School Climate Data to Promote Academic Achievement*. Their partnership with Panorama has resulted in: improved student-teacher relationships, which led to improved attendance; a shared understanding of student achievement across 15 buildings; data-driven conversations; and a reliable process to measure student voice and implement changes while monitoring progress.

Waltham Public Schools came to Panorama with a vision to deliver "excellence and equity" for every student — however, graduation rates were lower for underrepresented student groups. District leadership realized they needed to invest in streamlined data management and analysis, to bring to life a research-backed, data-driven way to monitor student progress and guide supports. Waltham is using 360-degree stakeholder feedback data to inform school practices and understand how different groups of students are experiencing school.





Goal Two – Staff Excellence and Professional Development

The Arlington Public Schools will recruit, hire, retain, and build the capacity of a diverse staff to be excellent teachers and administrators by providing high quality professional development aligned to needs, instructional support, coaching, and an evaluation framework that fosters continuous improvement.

How Panorama helps

Teachers and staff are the foundation of great schools. When teachers and staff feel supported, empowered, and trusted by school leadership, they are able to create the conditions that lead to students' academic, social, and emotional development. In addition to surveys developed specifically for teachers and staff, every Panorama partnership includes high-quality professional development tailored to each district's most pressing priorities. Users from Arlington Public Schools will benefit from: unlimited access to Panorama Academy, for on-demand tutorials and training; access to exclusive Panorama Community professional development events; and the custom design and facilitation of two virtual PD sessions up to two hours in length. In addition, users at Arlington Public Schools will have access to Playbook, a constantly growing online library of research-backed interventions. Playbook is Panorama's solution for helping educators move from data to action, and target specific categories or topics with SEL interventions and activities that are age-appropriate, flexible, low-lift, and designed to be integrated into the fabric of a classroom. Playbook content is developed by partners such as Teaching Tolerance, Second Step, Open Circle, CharacterStrong, Transforming Education, 7 Mindsets, Move this World, Conscious Discipline, and many other thought leaders who contribute to topics ranging from adult SEL to equity-centered SEL.

Client Spotlight

Wellesley Public Schools initially partnered with Panorama to support their emerging Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in collecting formative feedback and making data-driven decisions to promote staff recruitment, retention, and capacity, particularly for staff members of color. The district is leveraging the Panorama Teacher Survey to elevate teacher/staff voices to drive school improvement by measuring perceptions of their professional well-being; capacity and efficacy around supporting academic, social, and emotional learning; professional learning opportunities; cultural competency and awareness; school climate and culture; and relationships with colleagues, families, and school leadership. If teachers and school leaders have clear and actionable data about student experience, they will be able to take concrete steps to improving areas of opportunity in their schools and classrooms, improve instruction and climate, and increase outcomes for every student.

Pittsfield Public Schools is another Panorama partner that runs surveys for students, families, teachers, and staff, with a focus on reducing disparities between different groups of students for discipline and academics. Pittsfield was already thinking about building equity into everything they did, but their partnership with Panorama provided an opportunity to move past gathering and analyzing data to take action. In the fall of 2019, Panorama's Teaching and Learning team delivered equity-focused professional development training to Pittsfield's staff and board based on their survey results, and received a 100% satisfaction rating across all participants, a testament to Panorama's expert-led PD to advance equity and inclusion.





Goal Three – Resources, Infrastructure and Educational Environment

The Arlington Public Schools will offer a cost effective education that maximizes taxpayer dollars and utilizes best practices, academic research, and rigorous self-evaluation to provide students and staff the resources, materials and infrastructure required for optimum teaching and learning in a safe and healthy environment.

How Panorama helps

A Panorama partnership means access to research-backed, valid and reliable instruments for students, families, teachers and staff, that have been used at scale across the country (>500,000 responses per year¹); access to a large, responsive customer service team with experience supporting 32 of the 100 largest districts in the country and over 40 districts in Massachusetts in successfully implementing and administering similar survey projects; access to a growing resource on-demand library of comprehensive documentation, guidance, and support for administrators and educators to deepen their expertise, developed in partnership with leading firms like *Teaching Tolerance, Second Step, Open Circle, CharacterStrong, Transforming Education, 7 Mindsets, Move this World, Conscious Discipline,* and more; social-emotional learning measures that are aligned to the CASEL framework & family-engagement measures rooted in Dr. Karen Mapp's Dual-Capacity Building framework.

Panorama's survey content is developed under the leadership of Dr. Hunter Gehlbach, senior research advisor at Panorama and vice dean at the Johns Hopkins School of Education, and Dr. Samuel Moulton, director of research at Panorama with vigorous testing for <u>validity and reliability</u> for student surveys. Panorama moves quickly to respond to districts' needs individually and at scale. In response to the pandemic, Panorama developed content specifically designed to support districts ensure safe and effective reopenings with our <u>Distance Learning Surveys</u>, <u>Back-to-School Surveys</u>, and our <u>Teacher Well-Being Survey</u>.

Arlington Public Schools can enter a Panorama partnership with confidence to receive expertly and thoughtfully designed technology (surveys reporting platform), professional services (professional development workshops), and educational resources (Panorama Academy, recorded workshops, live training, and a growing intervention library called Playbook).

Client spotlight

Boston Public Schools began their partnership with Panorama in 2018 to collect student voice data, and the district has since expanded their Panorama partnership to survey all stakeholder groups and to support a district-wide initiative around early warning indicators (EWIs). Immediately following COVID-19 closures, BPS depended on Panorama to launch a confidential family survey to over 50,000 families in three short days. The survey was available in 10 languages, and was emailed, tweeted, and posted all over the school websites. The survey data highlighted significant discrepancies in experience based on demographic factors. Panorama has, and continues to support the district in understanding, acting on, and tracking their data.

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¹ Panorama's surveys are used at a much larger scale each year, but 500,000 is intended to represent a minimum threshold.





Goal Four - Operations, Communications and Stakeholder Engagement

The Arlington Public Schools will be run smoothly, efficiently and professionally. The district will operate transparently and engage in effective collaboration and responsive communication with all stakeholders. It will provide timely, accurate data to support financial decision-making, envisioning of the district's future, and long-range planning in partnership with other Town officials. Through these actions it will create broad support for a high quality education system, that is the community's most valuable asset.

How Panorama helps

Panorama provides several tools to open up channels for communication with family and community members belonging to Arlington Public Schools. Many Panorama partners take advantage of our translated survey content to administer surveys to families in English, Spanish, Haitian Creole, Portuguese, Arabic, Chinese, and other languages to ensure an inclusive, accessible, and equitable program. Many district partners also choose to share results from the Family-School Relationships Survey with their communities, resulting in improved family engagement and collaboration with all stakeholders. Districts have full control over the transparency of their survey results, and can choose to easily export reports and graphs for each of the following stakeholder groups: students, families, teachers and staff, and community members.

Client spotlight

Malden Public Schools is partnering with Panorama to amplify their family engagement efforts by first administering the new <u>Back-to-School Surveys</u> in multiple languages for a highly diverse student body, so that from an equity standpoint, the district is hearing from all three major stakeholder groups: students, families, and teachers and staff. The district is on track to measure and operationalize data from students' SEL while establishing a common language and data platform for school counselors, social workers, health teachers and administration.

Wake County Public School System's district leaders knew that they could better support each school's ability to develop meaningful relationships with families. WCPSS partnered with Panorama to administer surveys to their diverse families and uncovered through their data that Hispanic family responses were 18 percentage points below the overall Family Engagement score — a "gap" that educators are now working to close in partnership with their Panorama project team, mainly their Panorama Client Success Manager (CSM) and Account Director (AD).
