

Pass if a question or activity feels uncomfortable to you.


- **Protect other** people's feelings and protect your own and other people's privacy (no names). Don't ask personal questions of others.

Physical Changes Of Puberty

- Get taller
- Weight gain
- Muscle growth
- Grow hair under arms, on legs and around genitals
- Hair texture may change
- Hormones are raging
- Get acne
- Voice changes
- Sweat starts to smell
- Spontaneous erections (people who have a penis)
- Nocturnal emissions/wet dreams (people who have a penis)
- Grow breasts (people who have a vagina)
- Menstruation (people who have a vagina)


Social Changes of Puberty:

- May want to try more and riskier things.
- More interested in being with friends.
- May have more conflict with parents.
- Start to become interested in others as more than friends/crushes.

Emotional Changes of Puberty

- Mood swings/Intense feelings.
- Anxiety and stress.
- Feel self-conscious about how your body looks.
- Feel unsure a lot.
- Everyone's looking at/talking about you.



Reproductive Anatomy of People Who Have a Penis:



What is a Spontanious Erection? What are Nocturnal Emissions?



Erection (the swelling of the penis with blood, causing it to become firm).
Wet Dream/Nocturnal Emissions (when a fluid called semen (the fluid that contains sperm) releases from the penis.

Nocturnal Emissions So, how does a person deal with semen in a wet dreams?

When semen comes out of the penis it is usually a little sticky and white and in smaller amounts. It will usually be in your underwear and will come out in the laundry. It is a normal experience and part of puberty..







Reproductive Anatomy of People Who Have a Vagina:




Menstruation (People who have a Vagina) Not everyone gets periods so why do they need to know about periods then?



It's important to understand what someone else's body is doing so we can <u>be respectful</u>, <u>kind</u> and <u>understanding</u> of what another person might be going through.

What is Menstruation?

- The uterus is where a person can grow babies inside their body.
- So, once a person with a uterus is old enough and starts puberty, the uterus gets busy practicing. Blood is stored inside of the uterus lining the inside of the uterus.
- When the unneeded menstrual blood from a person's uterus is released from the body through the vagina.
- The blood flows down the vagina and out of the body.
- Commonly called "a period".
- Periods usually happen once a month.



Menstrual Blood (Vagina)

Menstrual blood is not blood from being hurt.

When period blood comes out of the vagina it can be messy. A person has to use products to stop and collect the blood as it comes out of the body.

Be prepared: Put a <u>Kit</u> in your backpack to be prepared (Sanitary Products, Clean Underwear).

Menstruation is a normal and important part of puberty.

You can always talk to a trusted adult about your worries or questions.
