Growing Our Own for Baltimore County Public Schools Scholarship Application for Aspiring Teachers Application Guidelines



Scholarship Purpose:	 Baltimore County Public Schools (BCPS) is currently experiencing a major teacher shortage, especially a shortage of teachers who are black, indigenous, people of color (BIPOC), teachers of special education and ESOL, and women in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) content areas. The Baltimore County Government has offered the Education Foundation of Baltimore County Public Schools, Inc. (The Foundation) a \$1 million dollar grant to support the efforts of the BCPS Department of Human Resources in recruiting, training, and retaining BIPOC teachers and women in STEM fields to teach in BCPS. The partners commit to providing \$1 million dollars to The Baltimore County Diverse 		
Scholarship Focus:	Teacher Recruitment Scholarship: <i>Growing Our Own for BCPS</i> in order to support college students in their Junior and Senior years, BCPS para-educators, conditional teachers contracted with BCPS, and career changers attending local Maryland colleges/universities and studying education by encouraging them to complete their internships in BCPS schools and commit to teaching in BCPS schools for the first three years after they graduate from their teacher education programs.		
Award Range:	Up to \$1 million - the award range will depend on the number of applicants.		
Eligibility:	 Must be a college student in the Junior or Senior year, a BCPS para-educator, and/or a career changer studying education between June 1, 2024 and June 30, 2026. Must be a student who is black, indigenous, a person of color (BIPOC), and/or a women pursuing a teaching certificate in science, technology, engineering, and/or math (STEM). Must provide verification of enrollment in a local accredited two- or four-year college or university. Must have a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA). Must personally write the <i>Growing Our Own for BCPS</i> Scholarship Application Essay. 		
Requirements:	 Meet all eligibility requirements. Complete internships in BCPS schools. Commit to teaching for 3 years in BCPS upon graduation from an accredited teacher-education program. 		
Funding:	 Funds for the Baltimore County Diverse Teacher Recruitment Scholarship: <i>Growing Our Own for BCPS</i> program will be grant funded by the Baltimore County Government. The grant funds will be held and disbursed as scholarships by The Foundation. The funds will be available between June 1, 2024, and June 30, 2026. The number of scholarships funded will depend upon the number of applicants. Scholarship Funds may be awarded between June 1, 2024, and June 30, 2026 for the following: Tuition
