## Student-Run Clubs

These clubs and activities provide students with additional opportunities to extend their learning, develop and demonstrate leadership, impact their school and community, expand their social network, and grow to be supported cognitively, emotionally and socially.

The guidelines are as follows: \*A student-interest club or activity may have access to school facilities for meetings during non-instructional time, subject to available space and the availability of staff supervision. \*A student-interest club or activity must complete an application for use of school district facilities and comply with other requirements under the Equal Access to School Facilities Policy. \*The student-interest club or activity will be listed in the handbook and on the website as a student-initiated club, which is not sponsored by the School District. Announcements and Postings: \*The student club will be allowed to announce their meeting dates, time and location using the student announcements, with prior approval of the school administration. \*The student clubs will be able to put a maximum of 10 posters/flyers no larger than 8 1/2 X 14 in the hallways, foyers and cafeteria areas of the school, with prior approval of the school principal. The School District will reserve the right to change the designated location for posters/flyers.
