COVID-RELATED PRECAUTIONS

Recognizing that the COVID-19 pandemic continues, The Fund II Foundation is following federal and state COVID-19 recommendations. - Participating youth and their parents/guardians are required to attend one pre-trip information session, scheduled for June 16 at 7:00pm ET. Parents/Guardians must RSVP using [this link](#).
- *NOTE: While you will not register them at this point, you should identify two (2) additional youth who can serve as alternates, if one of the four is not able to attend.*

WHICH YOUTH ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

The Restoration Retreat activities and experiences are designed to serve high potential young people who:

- Are 14-17 year old youth by the time they travel to Restoration Retreat, who identify as members of underrepresented and/or under-served communities, especially BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) and LGBTQ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer).
- Reside in under-served and/or under-resourced communities.
- Are nominated by staff member of participating organizations, and have been active for at least one year (12 consecutive months).
- Are physically able to
 - o Travel by airplane, bus and car;
 - o Lift and/or carry their luggage without assistance;
 - o Walk long distances in varying temperatures at varying altitudes without either assistance or assistive devices (due to terrain, location of facilities and activities).
 - o Able to obtain signed permission/waivers from their parents/guardians to attend and participate in the Restoration Retreat.

Youth with Special Needs: Fund II Foundation strives to provide positive Restoration Retreat experiences for children with various needs whenever possible. However, the Restoration Retreat is not designed to provide programs that are rehabilitative or therapeutic in nature, and does not specialize in serving children with special needs including children with significant physical, emotional, social, or behavioral difficulties. We appreciate the opportunity to work with you in order to determine if the Restoration Retreat experience is appropriate to meet the need of the young person you nominated.

- Be a paid employee at your organization,
- At least 30 years old,
- Have a deep connection (at least 12 consecutive months) to the youth, their families, communities and your organization,
- Able to travel with and lodge in close proximity to the youth,
- Be physically capable of full participation in Restoration Retreat activities,
- In their capacity as a Restoration Retreat chaperone, help us ensure safety by monitoring all youth, not just those representing your agency, and
- Be willing to coach and guide youth participants in a caring manner during the Restoration Retreat.
