She let me know that M had been saying she was sick a lot and missed some school, but recently confessed that she was being bullied. She also stopped working with the football team as a manager because of these issues. Her mom says she had been meaning to contact us about this but has been busy with work and moving. I talked to M and her brother in my office. She says it's one student but didn't feel comfortable giving me a name just yet. Her mom says she didn't want to be a "snitch" and tell her teachers. M says she hasn't been having problems with it this week, but I told her I would follow up with her in the morning.
