




Gender Identity

Our sense of being male, female, or some combination of the two (p. 481)









Sexual Orientation

Sex


In psychology, the biologically influenced characteristics by which people define "male" and "female" (p. 476)

What is **Assigned Sex** at Birth?

Assigned Sex at Birth is the sex that doctors assign to an infant after checking his/her genitals. Attributes such as chromosomes present, internal and external genital and reproductive anatomy, as well as hormones influence the doctors' assignment.










Gender Expression


Gender expression refers to the way a person communicates gender identity to others through behavior, clothing, hairstyles, voice or body characteristics (APA)
