You had asked me to send you in advance questions that the School Committee would like to have Senate President Spilka address during the legislative update on April 3rd. Here are some topics that have come up. I have not heard yet from some SC members so more might come up and I'll let you know if/when they do.

David, I am including you too in case this is helpful to you.

Topics:

- Fully funding circuit breaker

- Increasing Chapter 70 to be more aligned with inflation over the years, address funding cliffs, and to support increased needs of students post-pandemic

- Increasing METCO funding (it has been level funded)

- Ongoing concern that transportation bids are not competitive (single bid)

- Reform needed for FOIA requests. FOIA requests have been weaponized by the Far Right. The time to fulfill these is undermining capacity of educators to focus on Teaching and Learning and costing the districts the value of educator time and cost of legal services.

- Addressing "Parent Rights" challenges at the State level (e.g., requests for information on transgender students, increase in bullying against

transgender students, etc.)
