Waterloo Schools contributes textbooks, a district liaison for the students and the flexibility and support which allows the students to attend class while remaining employed. The McElroy Trust seeded funding for student tuition and fees, and now the Waterloo Schools Foundation supports these costs through a \$300,000 pledge.
