#### BACKGROUND

At the July 14, 2008 Board meeting, the Modesto City Schools Board of Education approved the Modesto City Schools' Strategic Plan for 2008-2011. One of the Five Essentials is Quality Leadership and one of the Shared Vision and Values states, "We will invest in continuous professional learning of our teachers, leaders, and staff."

#### <u>ISSUE</u>

The Human Resources Division is responsible for providing professional development activities that meet the goals of the Strategic Plan. In order to meet the goals of the Strategic Plan, a professional staff development program needs to be implemented to accelerate student learning through continuous improvement of teaching practices, leadership practices, and organizational practices.

#### PROPOSAL

Mutiu O. Fagbayi, President/CEO of Performance Fact, Inc., has submitted a leadership development program proposal that focuses on: Standards-based professional learning for school leaders, using root cause analysis to sharpen the focus on high-leverage teaching, leadership and organizational practices. 

#### **SERVICES AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into as of the date signed below, by and between Modesto City Schools, a public school district (MCS) and Performance Fact, Inc.

Whereas MCS has need of specialized services not otherwise available; and

Whereas CONTRACTOR represents that it has the specialized skill and knowledge to provide such services.

The parties do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. <u>SCOPE OF SERVICES</u> The Contractor shall perform the following service:
  Assist MCS Superintendent, Arturo M. Flores, the Board of Trustees, Superintendent's Cabinet, and school leadership team in developing and implementing a performance management system that will ensure a focus on disciplined implementation of MCS's Strategic Plan, annual performance ofjectives, milestones of progress and results for students.I
- LOCATION OF SERVICES Contractor shall render service(s) describe in Item 1 at the following location(s) Modesto City Schools and under the supervision of Arturo M. Flores
- 3. **TERM OF AGREEMENT** The term of this agreement shall begin July 1, 2008 and will terminate on June 30, 2009
- 4. COMPENSATION CONTRACTOR shall be compensated at the following rate:

  Modesto City Schools will pay Performance Fact a total of \$40,000 plus associated travel expenses (not to exceed \$2,000) for services.

  CONTRACTOR shall be allowed and authorized to incur and shall be reimbursed, in addition to the above rate for the following personal expenses attendant to the performance of services/ Miles @ mile or commercial

Supplies

Lodging

Meals

Total compensation shall not exceed \$40,000

- PAYMENT SCHEDULE Payment for the work shall be made upon submission of invoice for services rendered and the MCS' written approval of the work (which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld).
- 6. **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS** This agreement includes the general terms and conditions as set forth on the following pages, and the Contractor, by executing this agreement, agrees to comply with all such general terms and conditions.

- 7. <u>EMPLOYEES</u> Contractor shall at all times enforce strict discipline and good order among his/her employees and shall not employ or work any unfit person or anyone not skilled in work assigned to him or her. Any person in the employ of the Contractor whom the MCS may deem incompetent or unfit shall be dismissed from the job site and shall not again be employed at site without written consent from the MCS.
- 8. <u>CONTRACTOR SUPERVISION</u> When necessary, Contractor shall provide competent supervision of personnel employed on the job site, use of equipment, and quality of professional services.
- ASSIGNMENT OF AGREEMENT AND PURCHASE ORDER The Contractor shall not assign or transfer by operation of law or otherwise any or all of its rights, burdens, duties, or obligations under this agreement without the prior written consent of MCS.
- HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT The Contractor will indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Modesto City Schools and its agents, officers, and employees from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, judgments, liabilities, expenses, and other costs, including litigation costs and attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from, or in connection with the performance of this agreement. Such indemnification shall not extend to cover loss, damage, or expense arising from the sole negligence or willful misconduct of Modesto City Schools, its agents, officers, and employees.
- 11. <u>TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT</u> This Agreement shall terminate on the last day of service as written in Article 3 except:
  - MCS may terminate at any time if CONTRACTOR does not perform, or refuses to perform according to this Agreement.
  - b. MCS may terminate services of CONTRACTOR at any time if, in the professional judgment of the management supervisor named herein, CONTRACTOR's performance is unsatisfactory as to the manner of performance or the product of said performance fails to meet the MCS' requirements.
  - c. In the event of early termination, CONTRACTOR shall be paid for all work or services performed to the date of termination together with an amount of approved expenses due and owing.
  - d. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time during the term of this agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice.
- 12. <a href="PERMITS AND LICENSES">PERMITS AND LICENSES</a> The Contractor and all of his employees, agents, and Sub-Contractors shall secure and maintain in force, at Contractor's sole cost and expense, such licenses and permits as are required by law, in connection with the furnishing of services, materials, or supplies herein listed.
- 13. <u>CONTRACTOR NOT OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT OF MCS</u> While engaged in carrying out other terms and conditions of this agreement, the Contractor is an independent Contractor, and not an officer, employee, agent, partner, or joint venture of the MCS.
- 14. ANTI-DISCRIMINATION It is the policy of the Modesto City Schools Board of Education that in connection with all work performed under agreements, there be no discrimination against any employee engaged in the work because of race, religion, ethnic background, or national origin, language, gender, sexual orientation, economic status, physical or developmental disabilities, or other special needs, and therefore the Contractor agrees to comply with the applicable Federal and California Laws, including, but not limited to the California Fair Employment Practice Act, beginning with Labor Code, Section 1410 and Labor Code, Section 1735. In addition, the Contractor agrees to require such compliance by all Sub-Contractors employed on the work by him.

- 15. <a href="INSURANCE">INSURANCE</a> The Contractor shall not commence work under this Agreement until he has obtained the insurance required under this paragraph and satisfactory proof of such insurance has been submitted and approved by MCS. Except for worker's compensation insurance, the policy shall not be amended or modified and the coverage amounts shall not be reduced without MCS prior written consent. MCS shall be named as an additional insured and be furnished thirty (30) days written notice prior to cancellation.
  - a) WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE The Contractor shall procure and shall maintain during the life of this agreement Worker's Compensation Insurance on all of his employees to be engaged in work on the project under this agreement.
  - b) PUBLIC LIABILITY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this agreement, a policy of Public Liability Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 CSL for bodily injury and property damage, which policy shall name the MCS an additional insured.
- 16. GOVERNING LAW This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.
- 17. <u>ATTORNEYS' FEES</u> If any action is brought by either party against the other party hereunder, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the other party reasonable attorneys' fees, costs and expenses incurred in connection with the prosecution or defense of such action.
- 18. MODIFICATION Any waiver, amendment, modification, consent or acquiescence with respect to this agreement or any provision of this agreement or with respect to any failure to perform in accordance therewith shall be set forth in writing and duly executed by or on behalf of the party to be bound thereby.
  - No changes or alterations to this agreement shall be made without specific prior written approval by the MCS.
- 19. MCS' RIGHT OF RETENTION MCS shall become the owner of and entitled to exclusive possession of all records, documents, graphs, photographic or other reproductions of any kind produced in the scope of services performed and no other uses thereof will be permitted except by permission of the MCS. Proprietary materials will be exempted from this clause.
- 20. **SEVERABILITY** If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, that provision shall be severed from the Agreement and the remaining provisions shall remain in effect.
- 21. **FORCE MAJEURE** Neither party shall be liable under the agreement as a result of any delay, failure or interruption resulting from acts of God, acts of civil or military authorities, acts or orders of governmental authorities, catastrophes or any other occurrences or circumstances beyond the parties' reasonable control.
- 22. ENTIRE AGREEMENT This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of this agreement. There are no agreements, understandings, representations or warranties, whether written or oral, between the parties other than those set forth in this agreement.
