Recommended Action

It is recommended that the governing board take action on the three year MOU proposal by Improve Your Tomorrow, Inc.

Background

Improve Your Tomorrow (IYT) was founded in 2013 with the mission to increase the number of young men of color (YMOC) attending and graduating from colleges and universities. The organization offers a comprehensive program to address academic disparities, and build a college and career and community pipeline. The program strives to create systemic and societal change where men of color are overrepresented in higher education, underrepresented in the criminal justice system, and become leaders in their local communities. The organization has a positive track record of dramatically increasing academic achievement and college attendance, while solidifying the mental health and wellness of YMOC in their program. IYT currently serves 3,000 YMOC across Northern and Central California.

Description

Although Improve Your Tomorrow (IYT) intends to implement their program using the IYT College Academy designation, it should be noted that the Academy is not a school but a program, which is open to all students. IYT seeks to break the generational cycles of low educational attainment by providing mentorship, member development, parent engagement, internships, college tours, and tutoring sessions at school sites. The program would like to serve 150 students who experience academic and personal challenges at Hogan Middle School (50 students) and Jesse Bethel High School (100 students). IYT will identify key performance indicators for the two sites to assess program effectiveness. IYT will submit an evaluation form to the district and the identified school sites for review.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of the program will be \$270,200 annually for three years. The cost will be encumbered out of the A - G Improvement Grant and ESSR funding. The program is aligned with LCAP Goal 1.5a (Site-Based Tutoring and Parent Engagement) and LCAP Goal #3.9 (College Preparatory Program).
