Hello,

I am writing to share that I would like you to add your name to the Ceasefire NOW resolution introduced by Cori Bush, et al calling for an immediate ceasefire by Israel and the opportunity for humanitarian assistance to be allowed into Gaza. Furthermore, I would like to state my unequivocal stance against ANY American troops being sent to help Israel unless the conflict widens to include other countries. At this point Israel has more than tripled the initial death toll caused by the Hamas terrorist attack. What they are doing now is starting to feel like war crimes against the Palestinian people.

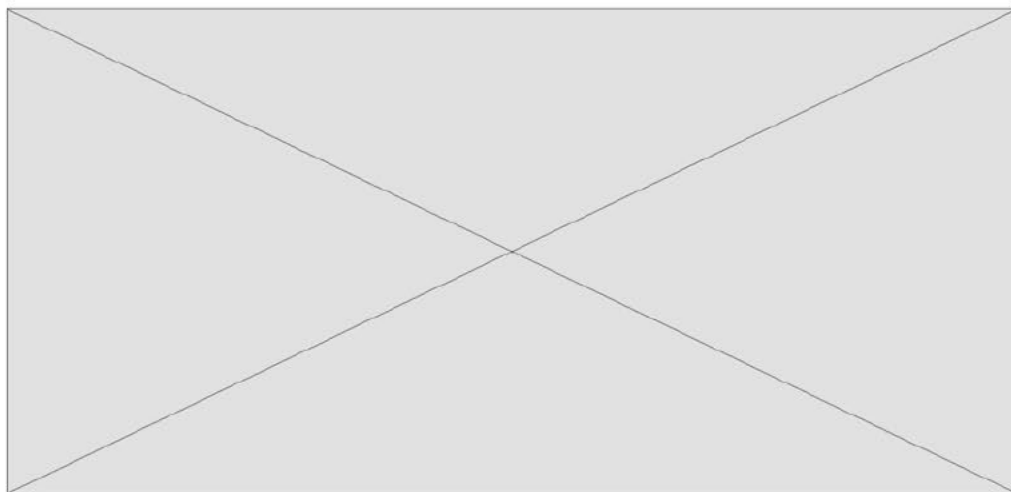

Dear [REDACTED],

The tears Palestinians have shed this week could fill oceans.

Today in Gaza, people are praying every hour that they will be alive the next, making peace with their loved ones, and evacuating one shelter for the next.

To address this disaster, Representatives Cori Bush, Rashida Tlaib, Andre Carson, Summer Lee, and Delia Ramirez introduced a resolution today calling for an immediate ceasefire, and for humanitarian assistance to be allowed to enter Gaza. This afternoon I joined Representatives Bush, Tlaib, and Pressley at a press conference to present the Ceasefire NOW resolution.

Write to your members of Congress now and ask them to add their name to the resolution, or thank them if they've signed on already.

Israel is dropping bombs across one of the most densely populated areas on the planet, and they've cut 2.3 million people off from food, water, fuel, and electricity.

No electricity means that hospitals cannot save lives, the communication has collapsed, and water can not reach people.

If you are living in the United States you have an important role to play.

With one call, President Biden could demand a ceasefire and pressure Israel to stop immediately. We've seen it happen before.

Write to your members of Congress now.

More than 1030 children have already been killed by Israeli bombs \*this week\*.

But instead of calling for a ceasefire, the U.S. is preparing 2,000 troops for potential deployment in Israel as of this morning.

Fueling more attacks on the people of Gaza is unthinkable. The US must reassess its failed foreign policy approach to the region and address the root causes of violence: Israeli apartheid, settler colonialism, and a suffocating 17 year siege.

Further arming Israel and sending troops is the absolute wrong direction.

We must call for a ceasefire now to prevent further atrocities and massive loss of life.

If we can get a significant number of representatives to sign onto this resolution we can push the Biden Administration to act quickly and end this now.

History is asking us to step up to this moment with everything we've got to stop a genocide taking place as we speak.

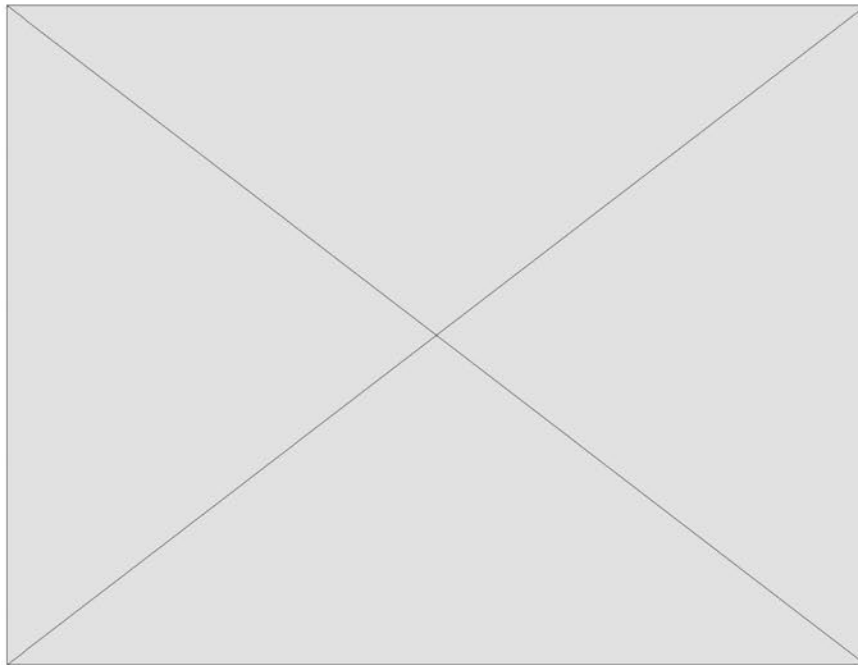
