

Through history, systematic roadblocks have been created between boys & young men of color and opportunities to reach their full potential.






Underperforming Schools

school.




Out- of School Suspensions

4 Year Graduation Rate Black and Hispanic males are less likely to graduate in four years.




High School Drop Out Black males are twice as likely to drop out of high school because of incarceration.




Life Expectancy




Compared to 73% of African American males and 79% of Latino Males in California



#### **Member Recruitment**


Students are invited to presentations and rush activities.
