I am reaching out to you regarding the 6-week Leadership Development program offered by CAIR for school-aged students. We have successfully launched the program at Starr King and are looking to expand it to other schools. We are hoping that you could assist us in connecting with schools that may benefit from our program.

Here is some information about the program:


The Leadership Development program is a 6-week program designed for Afghan youth (aged 13-18) who have recently arrived in the US (post-August 2021). The program aims to equip them with the necessary tools, knowledge, and support to understand their new communities while celebrating their cultural identity. Through this program, we hope to foster understanding and empower the youth to reach their full potential. The session duration can range from 45 minutes to 2 hours.

The topics covered in the program include:

- Civic Engagement
- College Career Readiness/pathways
- Leadership Skills/Financial Literacy
- Personal empowerment through Islam
- Cultural Awareness and understanding
- Mental and emotional health awareness
