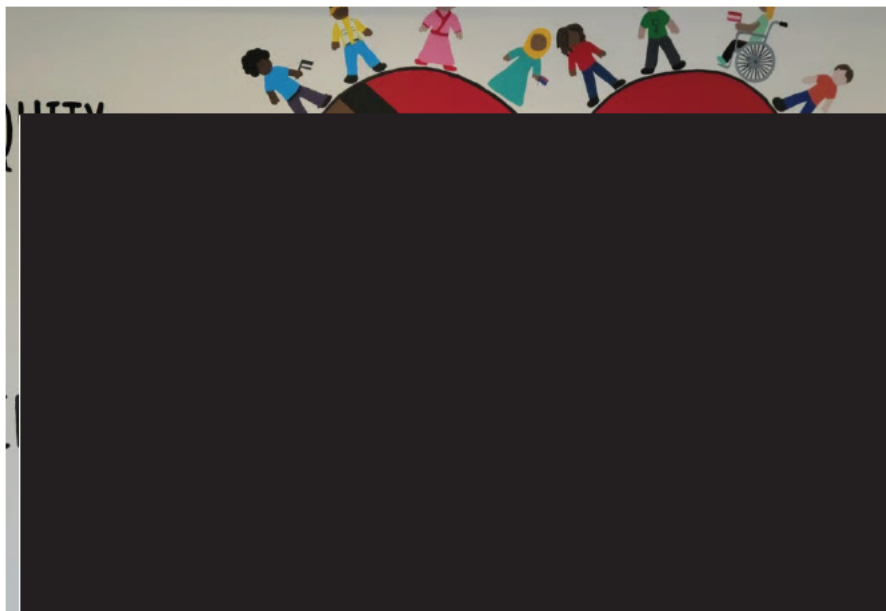


“Celebrate our Differences – Equality Mural” at KPMS
